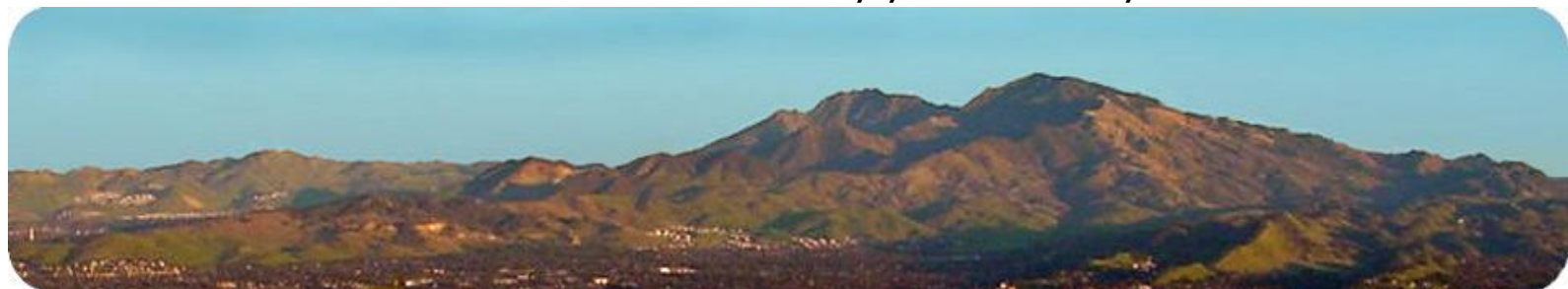

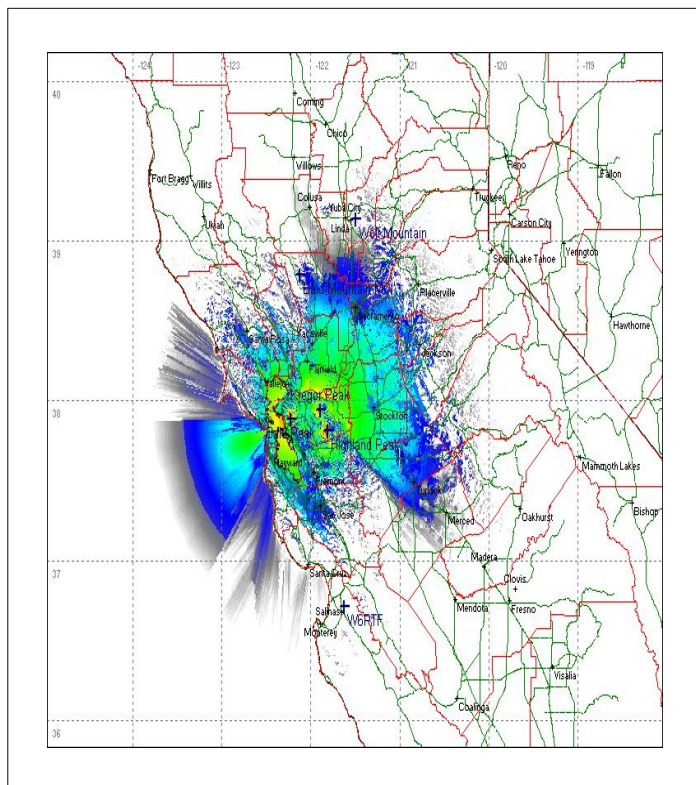
COVERAGE MAP OF THE WA6HAM VHF REPEATER

The system covers the San Francisco, Oakland and San Jose area as well as the Sacramento - San Joaquin Valley's of northern California.
